Please submit your exciting input relating to topics like:

- OPC UA in hardware-constrained devices
- OPC UA, including C2C functionality via UAFX
- OPC UA, including IT infrastructure like APL, SPE, TSN, 5G,
- OPC UA Safety

5. **Cloud Interoperability**

Innovations, standards, and case studies related to interoperability in scenarios like:

- Interoperability between OT and IT, like OPC UA over MQTT or REST
- Interoperability between Digital Twins
- Interoperability and other information regarding DataSpaces
- Interoperability, information modelling of, and connectivity for Metaverses

Research and practices or insights into implementations addressing topics like:

- EU Digital Product Passport (DPP)
- Product Carbon Footprint (PCF)

Strategies and solutions for integrating new technologies into existing systems or infrastructure like:
